INTRODUCTION

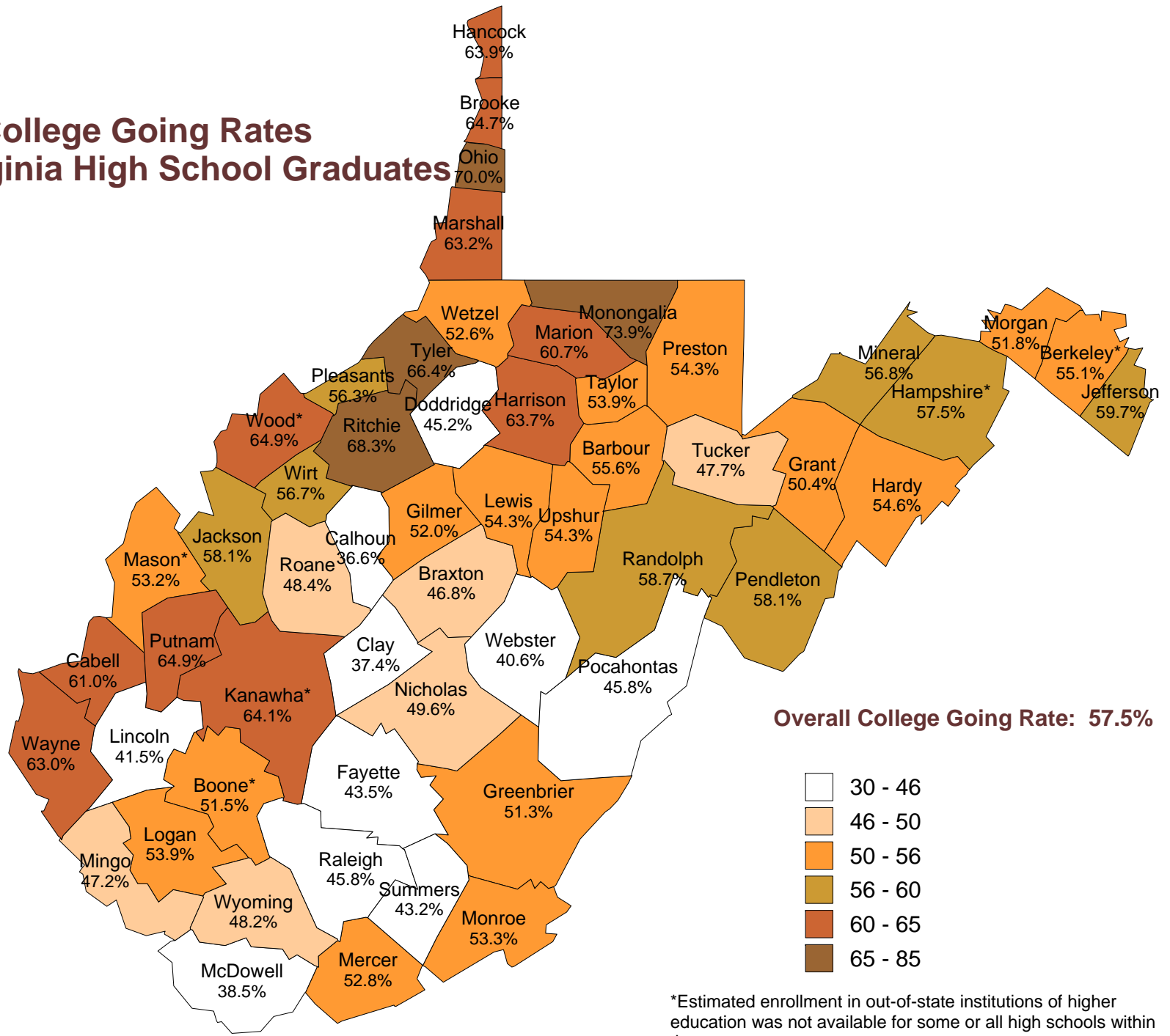

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2007

- Of the 17,914 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2006-07, an estimated 10,292 **(57.5%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the Fall 2007 semester. This represents almost a **1% decrease in the overall rate** since last year. Decreases were witnessed by the WV public four-year, WV degree-granting proprietary, and out-of-state institutions, while increases were noted in the WV public two-year and WV independent institutions. The number of WV high school graduates rose by 2.7%.
- 8,752 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.4%), independent (4.6%), or degree-granting proprietary (0.8%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 48.9%**, which represents **no change over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in Fall 2007, it is estimated that another 1,540 **(8.6%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a **0.8% decrease** from 2006's figure of 9.4%.

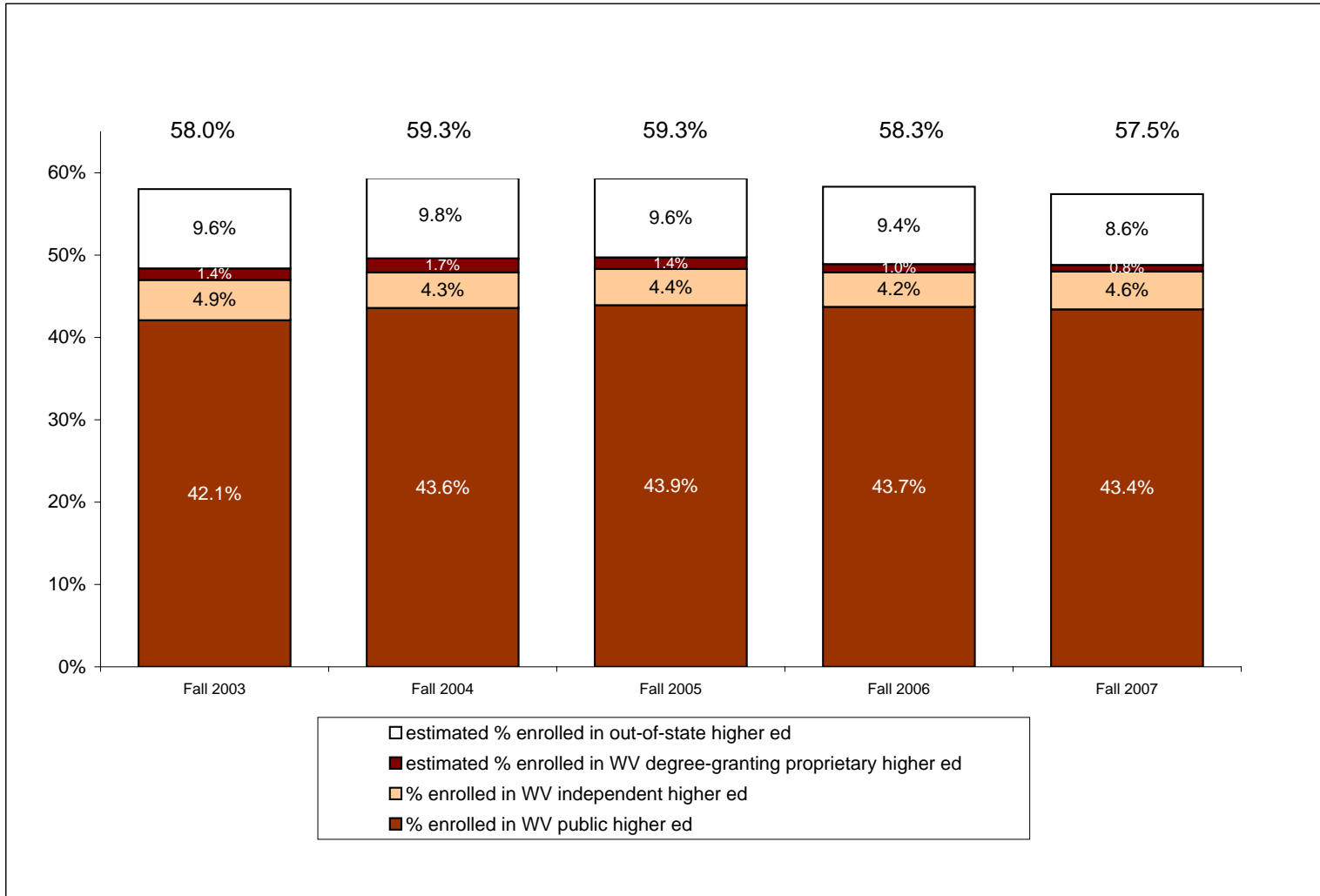

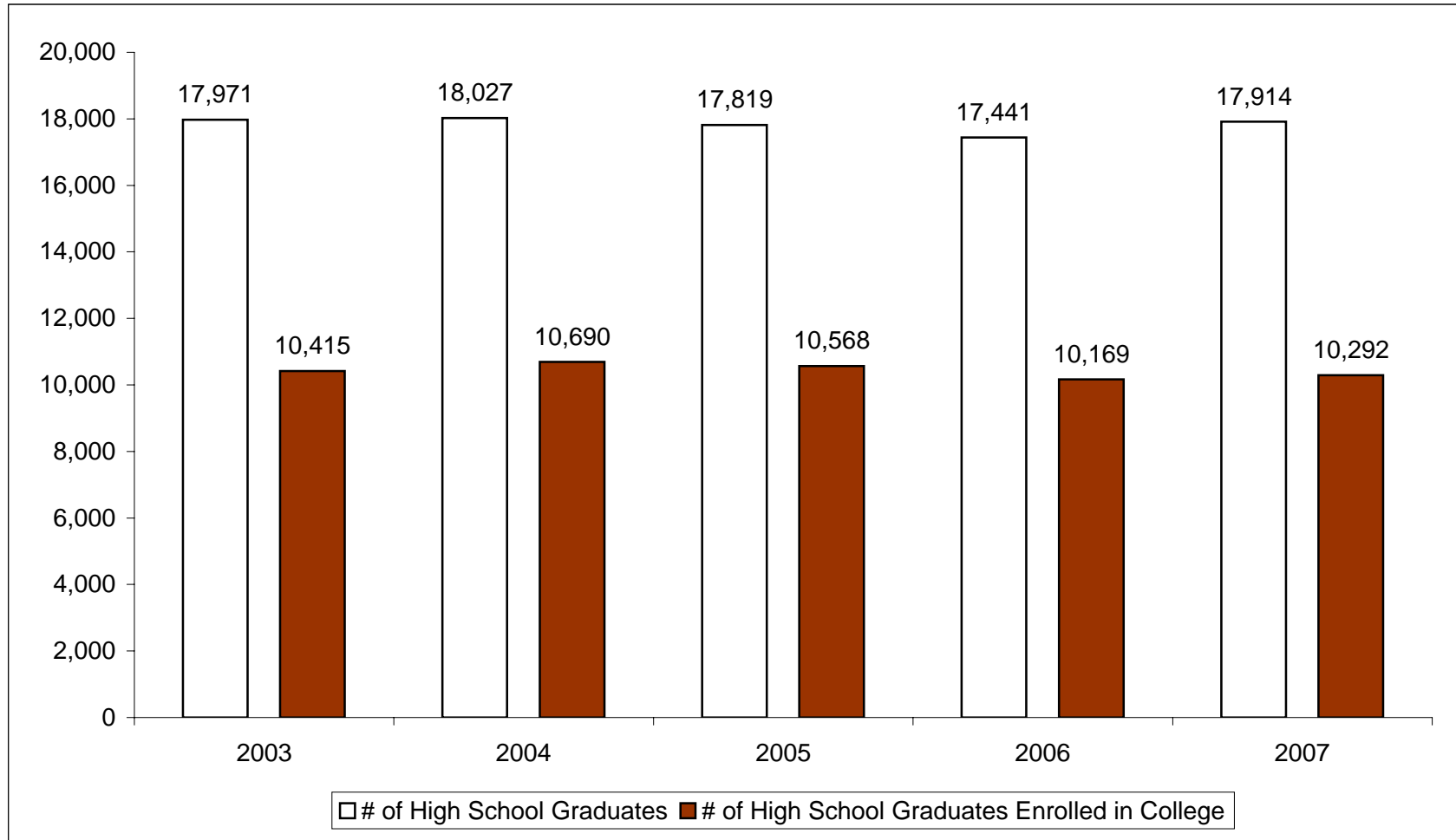

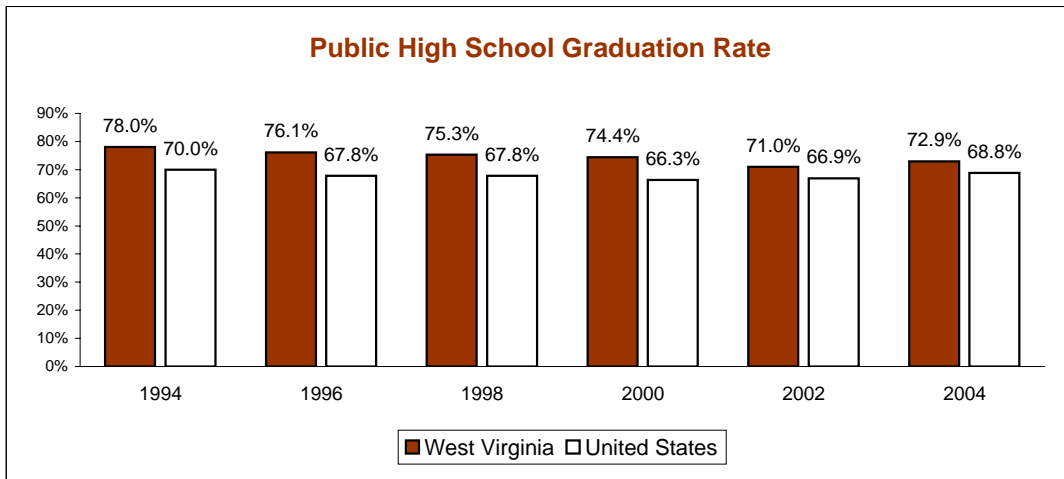

2003-2007



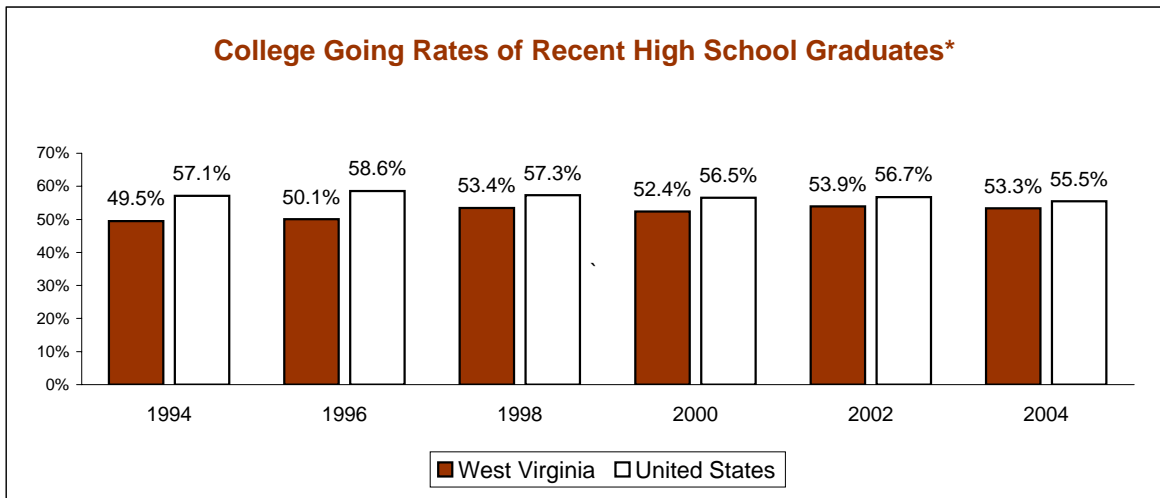

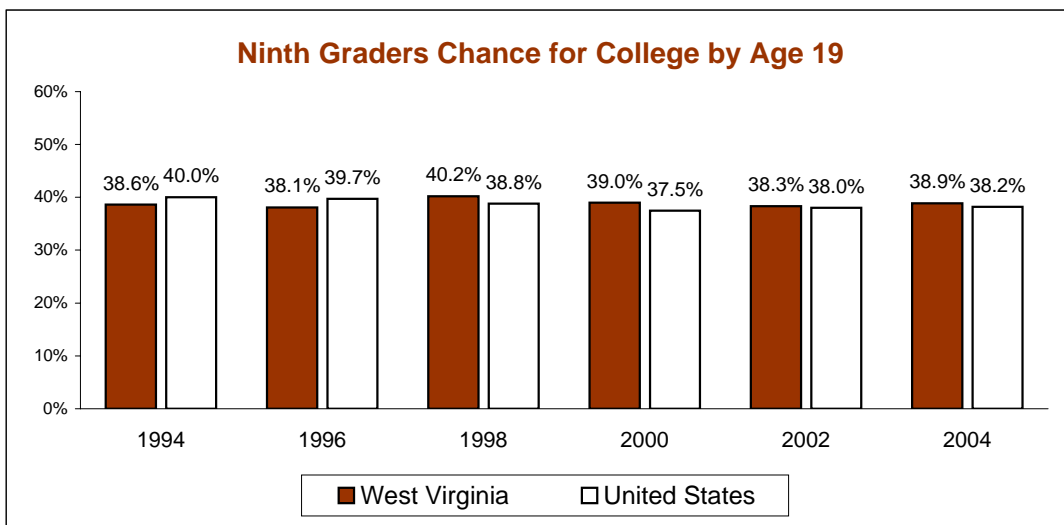
