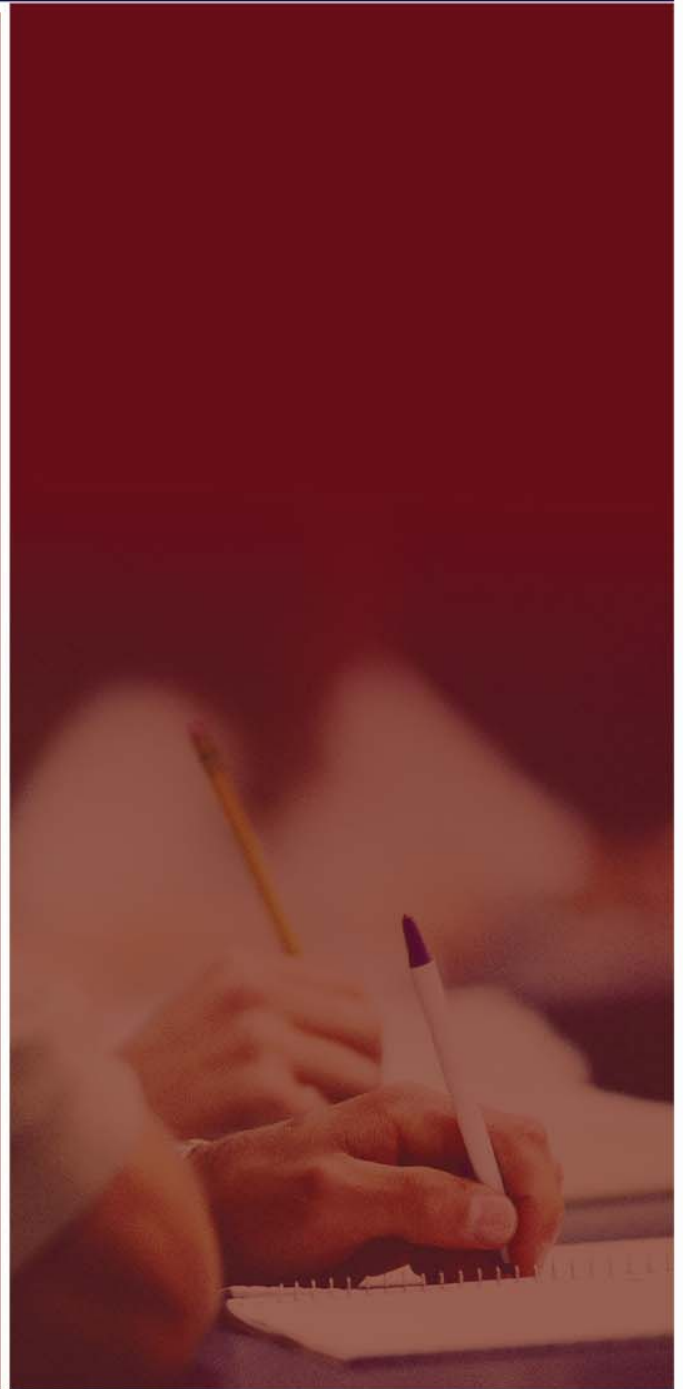

INTRODUCTION

Every year, the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission Office of Research and Technology compiles a listing of West Virginia's college going rates by county and high school. This report would not be possible without the gracious hard work and contributions from the colleges and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education.

The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels, and college going rates are important goals for the betterment of the State and its economy. The college going rate echoes the successes of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, students, and parents in contributing to the State's education system as a whole. 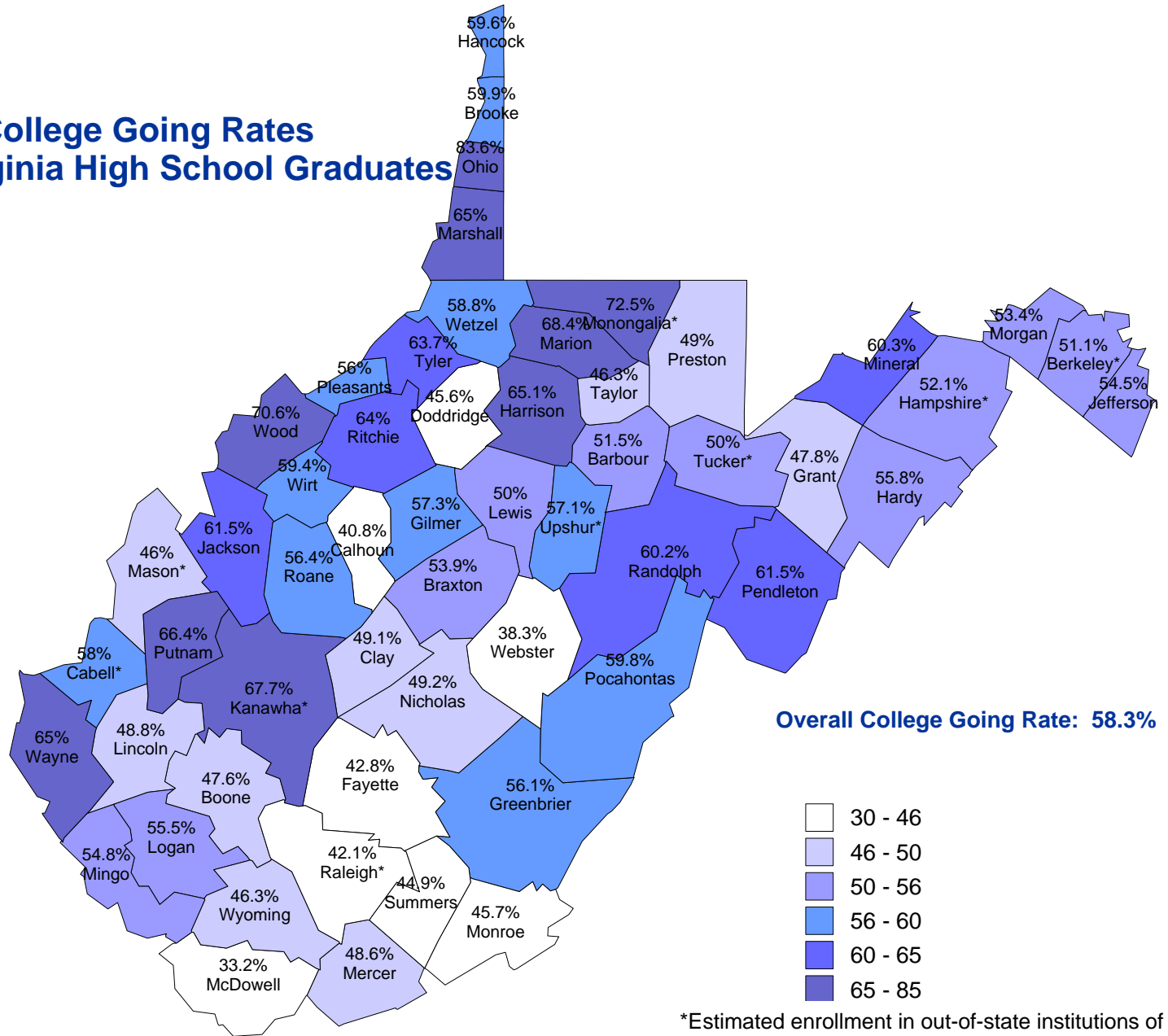

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2006

- Of the 17,441 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2005-06, an estimated 10,169 **(58.3%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the Fall 2006 semester. This represents a **one percent decrease in the overall rate** since last year. Each sector of higher education witnessed a decrease to some extent.
- 8,526 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.7%), independent (4.2%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.0%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 48.9%**. This is a **0.8% decrease** over last year's figure of 49.7%.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in Fall 2006, it is estimated that another 1,643 **(9.4%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a **0.2% decrease** from 2005's figure of 9.6%.
- The most current national data (2004) showed a 53.3% college enrollment rate for West Virginia high school graduates, compared to the 55.5% national average, thereby producing the narrowest gap between the two in over a decade.

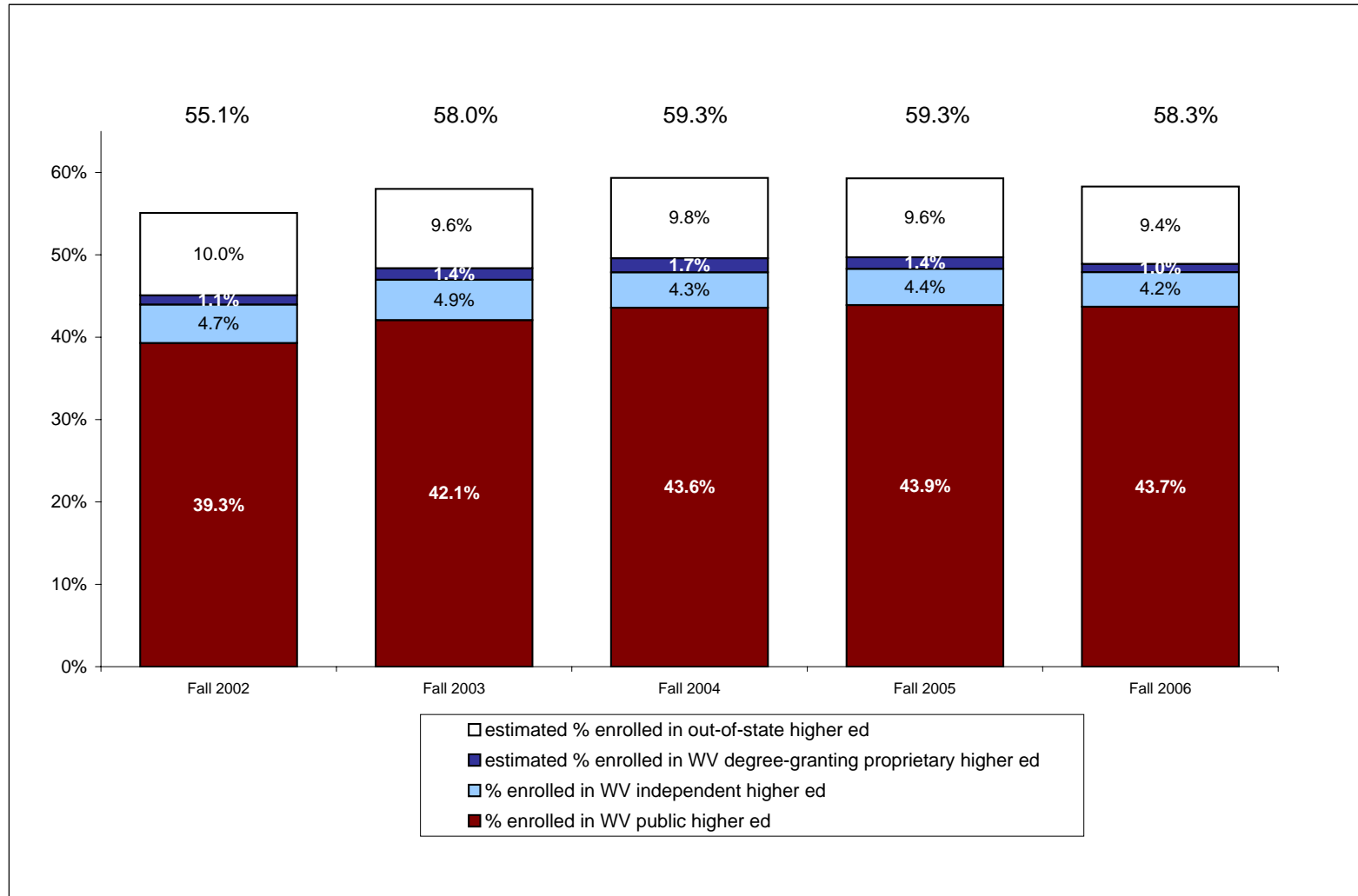

Fall 2002 to Fall 2006

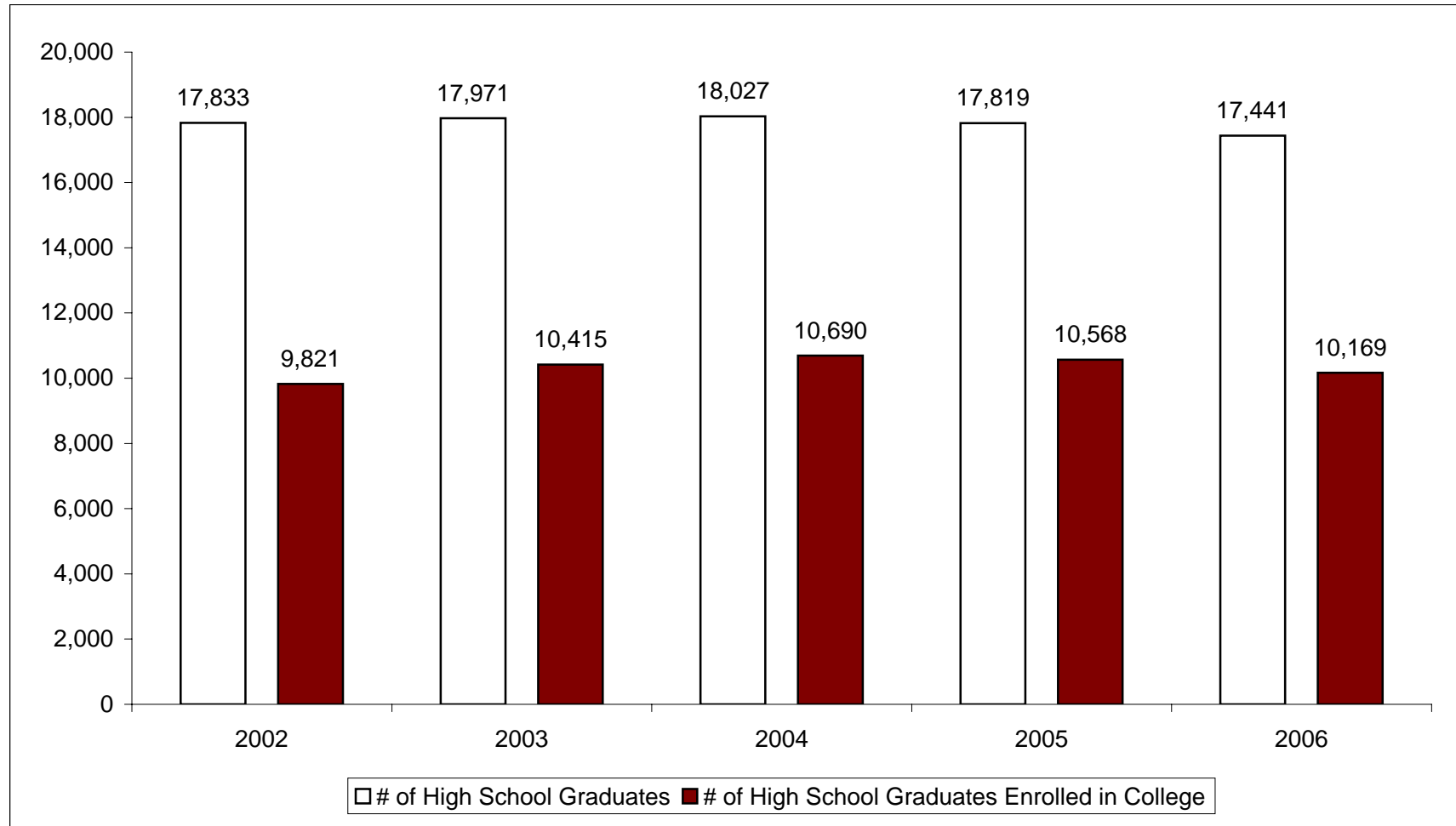

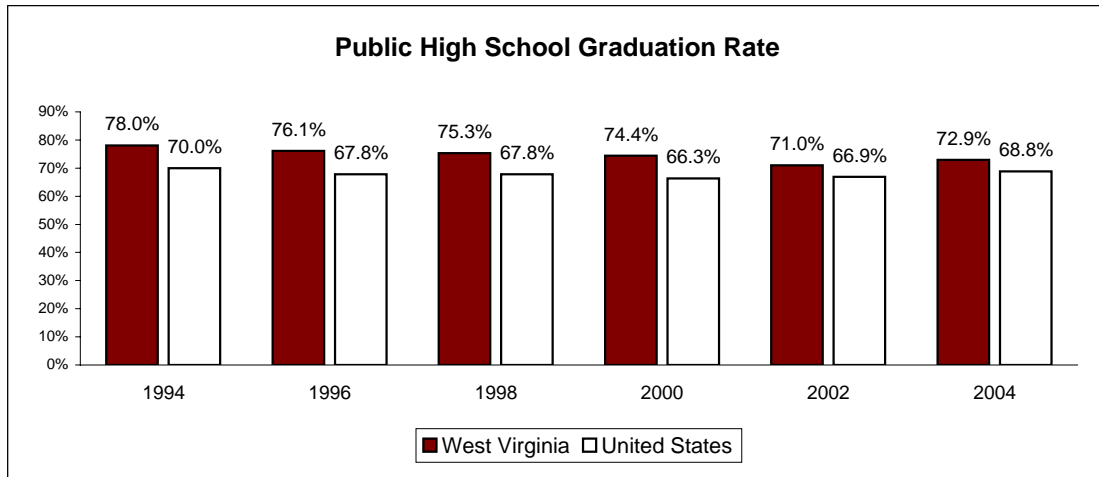
West Virginia High School Graduates and Graduates Enrolling in College 2002-2006



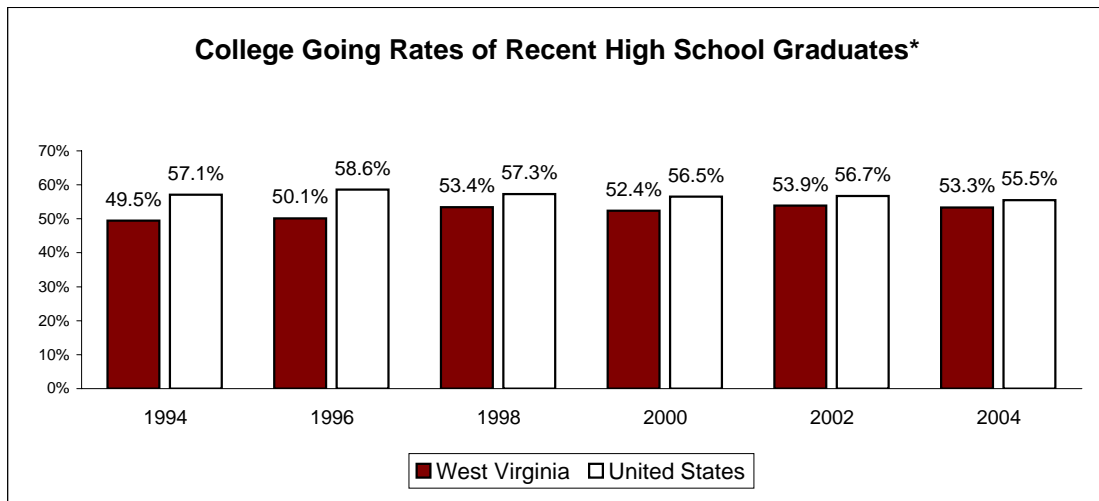

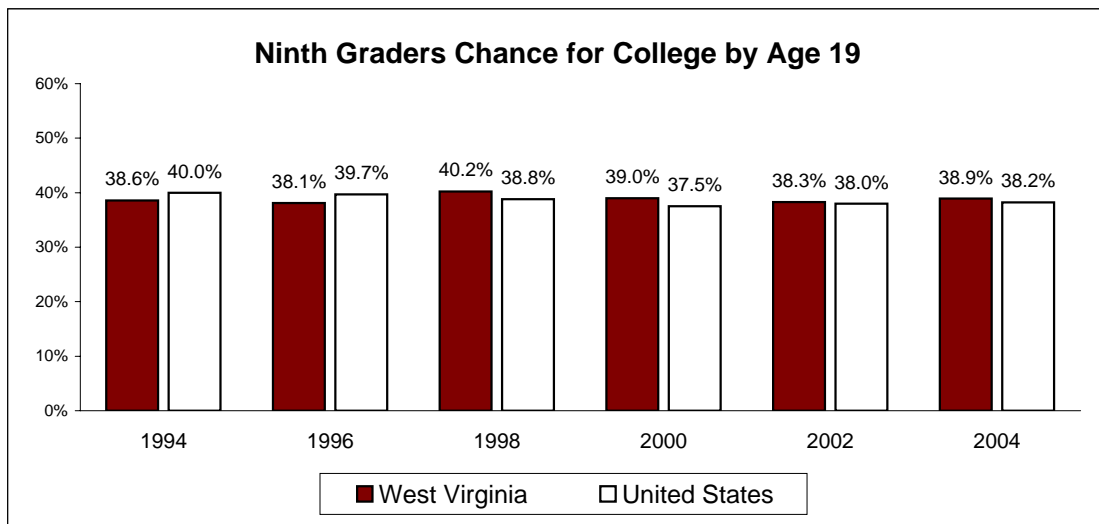
