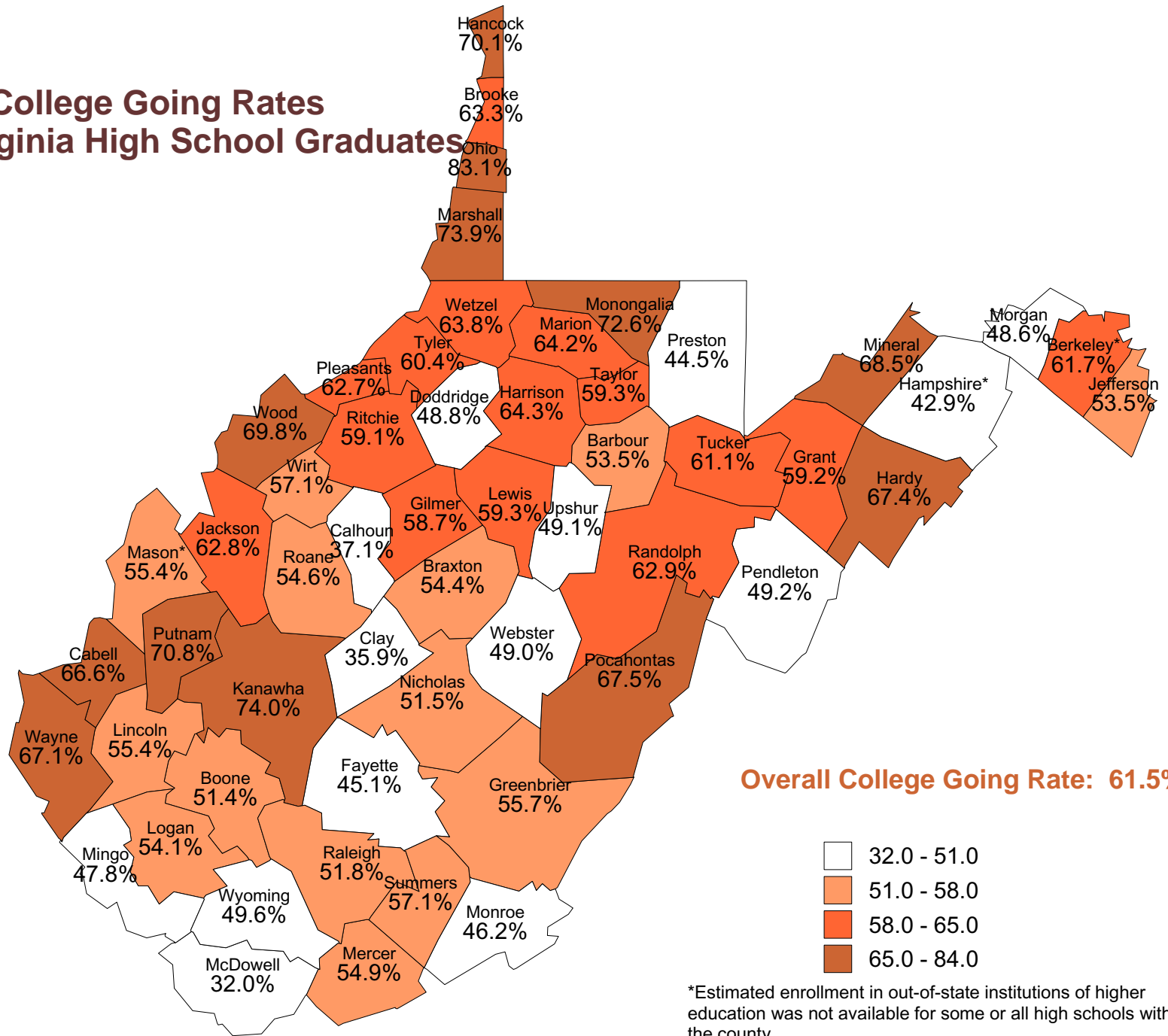

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2009

- Of the 18,418 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2008-09, an estimated 11,328 **(61.5%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the fall 2009 semester. This represents **an increase of 2.7 percentage points in the overall rate** since last year and the largest increase since 2003. Every sector of higher education experienced an increase, with the West Virginia public two-year sector showing the largest gain from 10.9% to 11.8%.
- 9,651 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (46.4%), independent (4.6%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.4%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 52.4%**, which represents **an increase of 2.3 percentage points over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2009, it is estimated that another 1,677 **(9.1%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects an increase of half a percentage point over last year's figure.

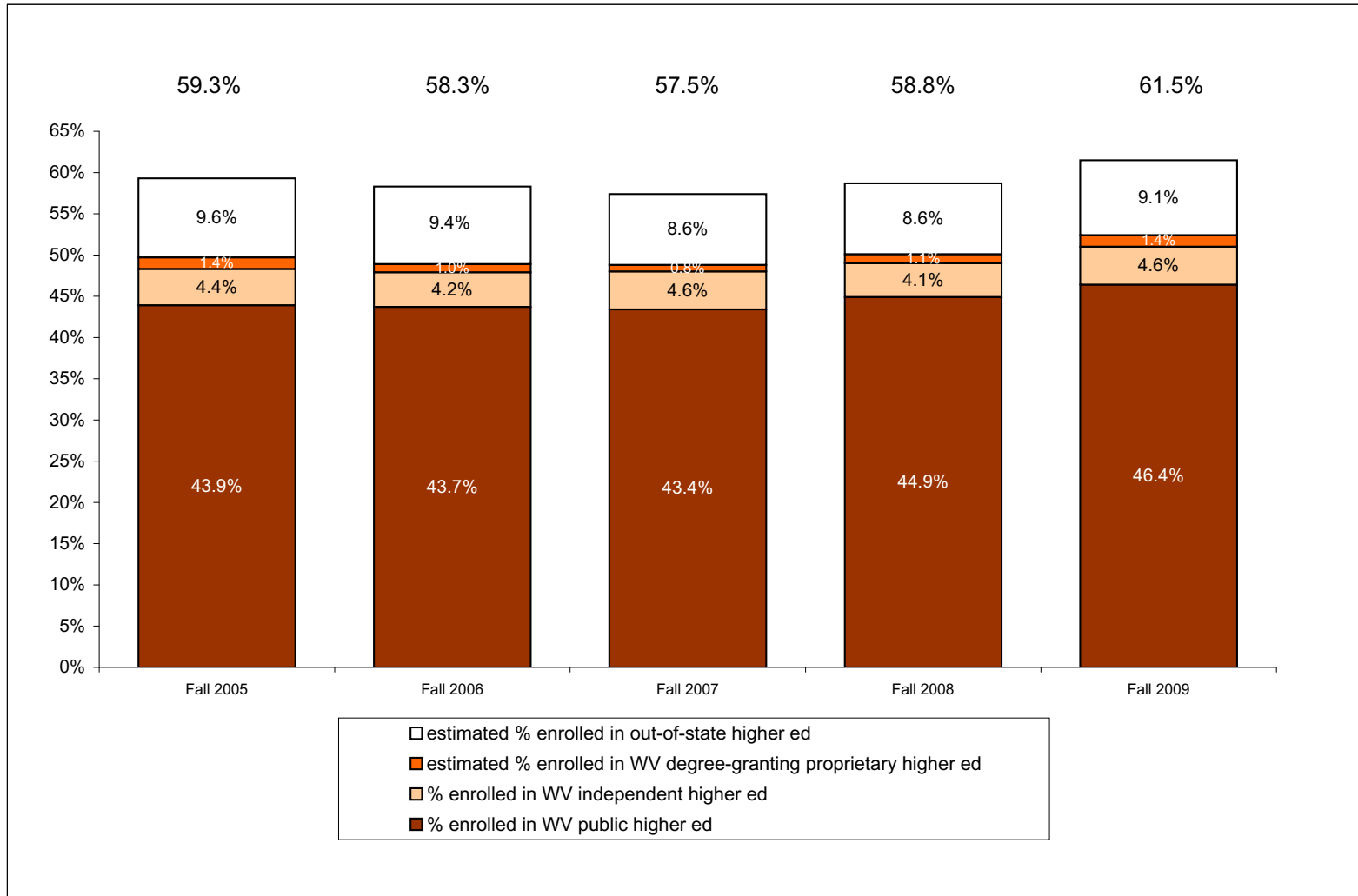

2005-2009

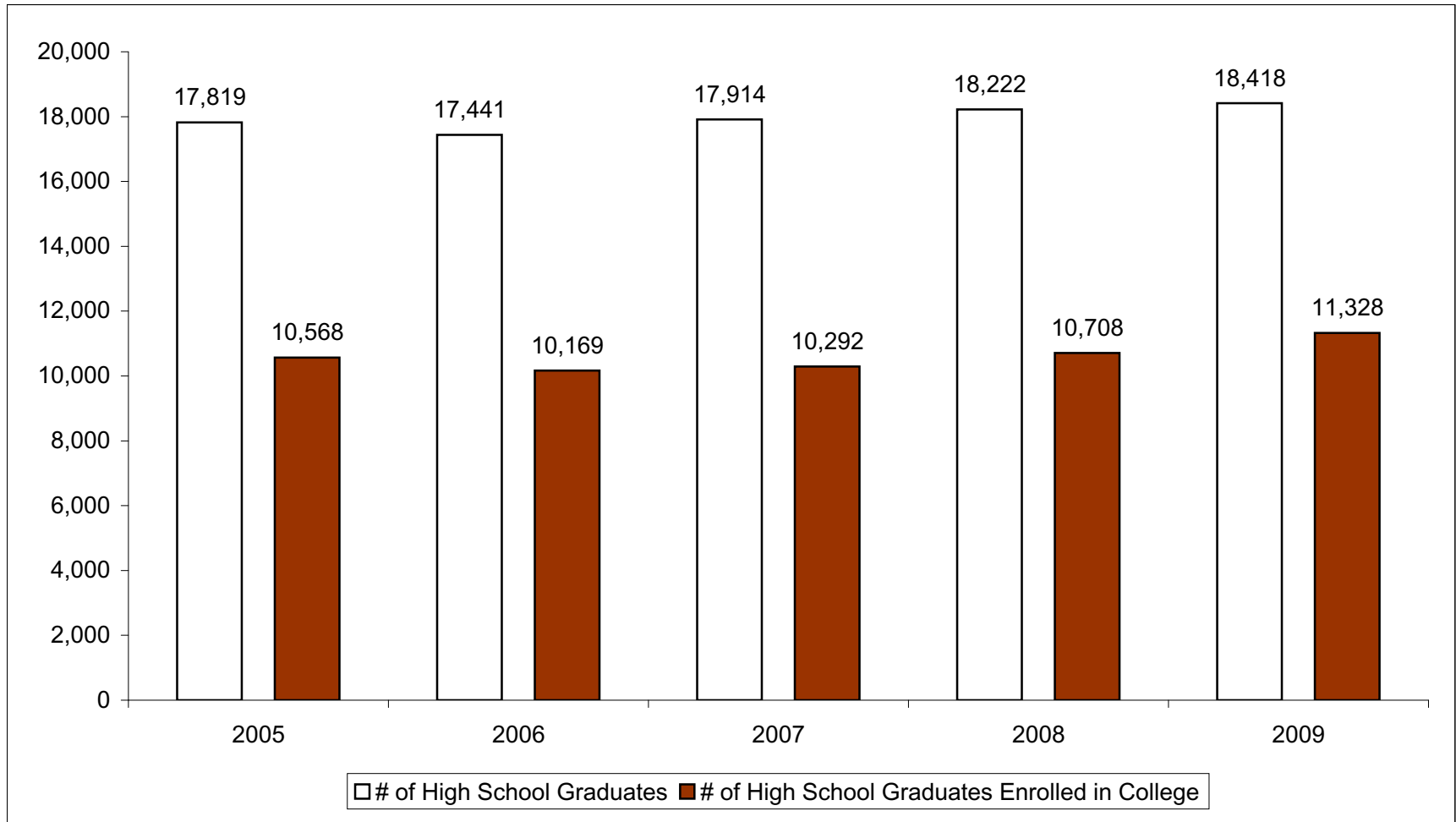
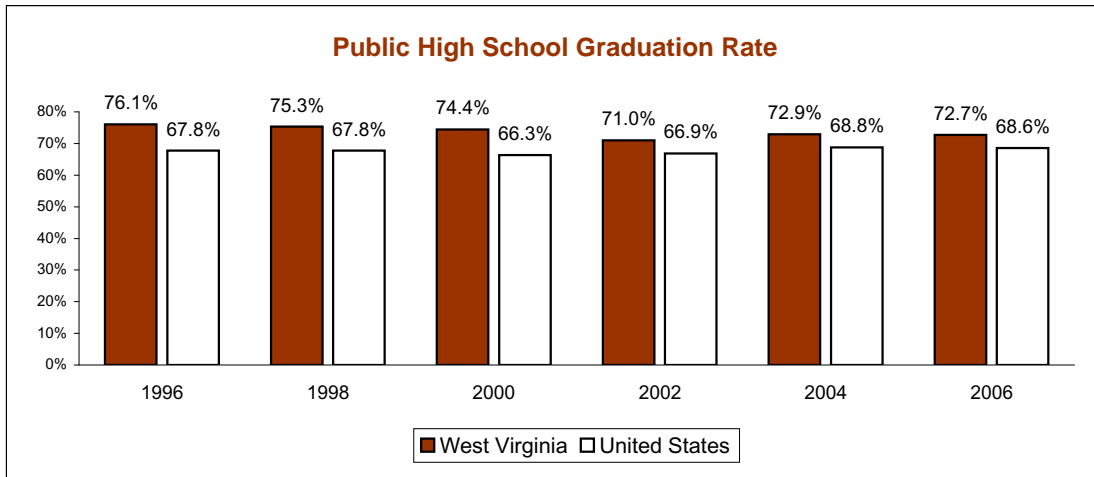
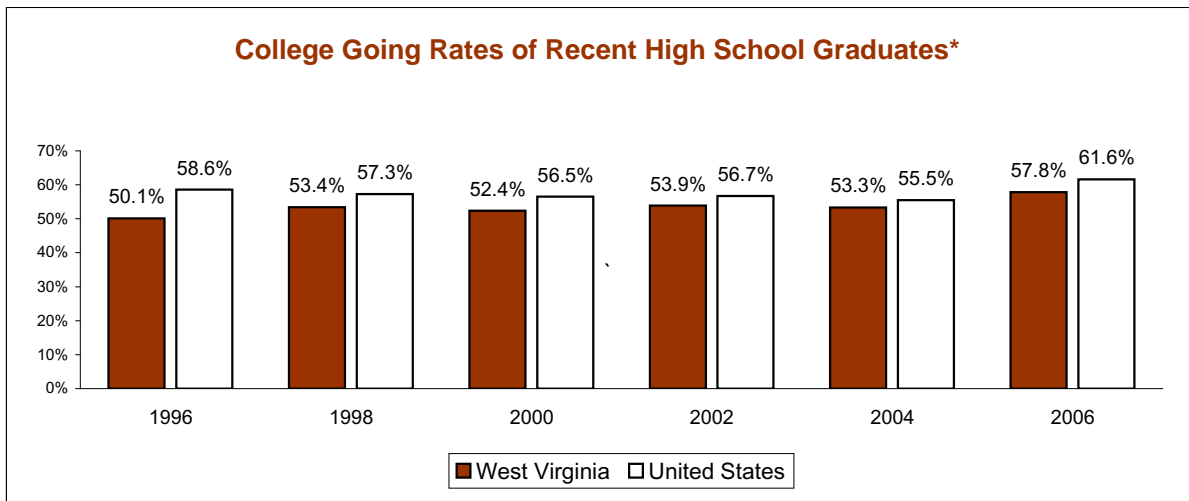

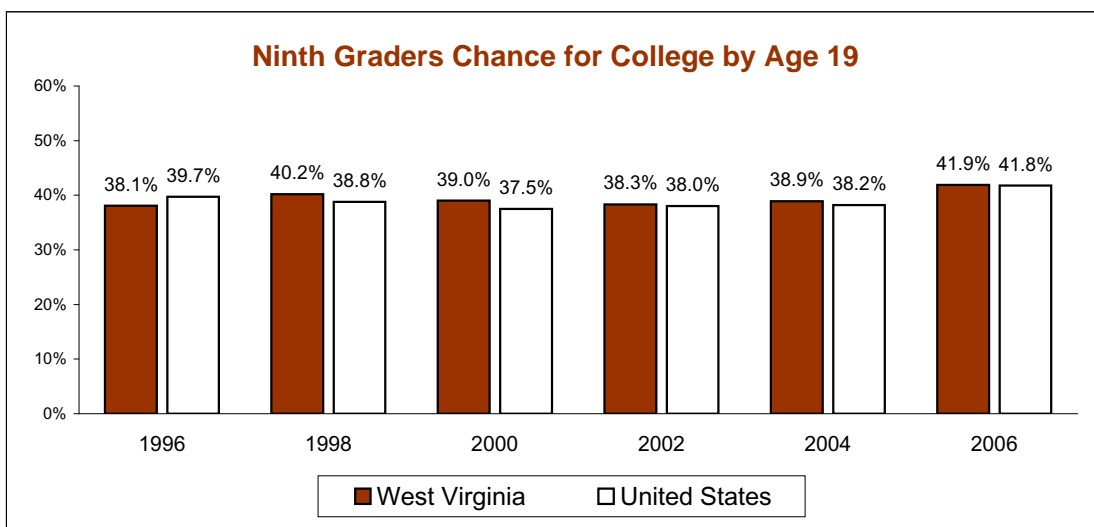
