

# West Virginia College Going Rates By County and High School Fall 2011

## INTRODUCTION

Every year, the West Virginia Higher Education Policy Commission's Division of Policy and Planning compiles a listing of West Virginia's college going rates by county and high school. This report would not be possible without the gracious hard work and contributions from the colleges and universities, high schools, county superintendents, and the West Virginia Department of Education.

The improvement of literacy rates, educational levels, and college going rates are important goals for the betterment of the State and its economy. The college going rate echoes the successes of the Governor, legislators, government agencies, students, and parents in contributing to the State's education system as a whole. Success in this area is hard-won through diligence and constant attention. The attached report makes an effort to document progress to identify areas for continued efforts for improvement.

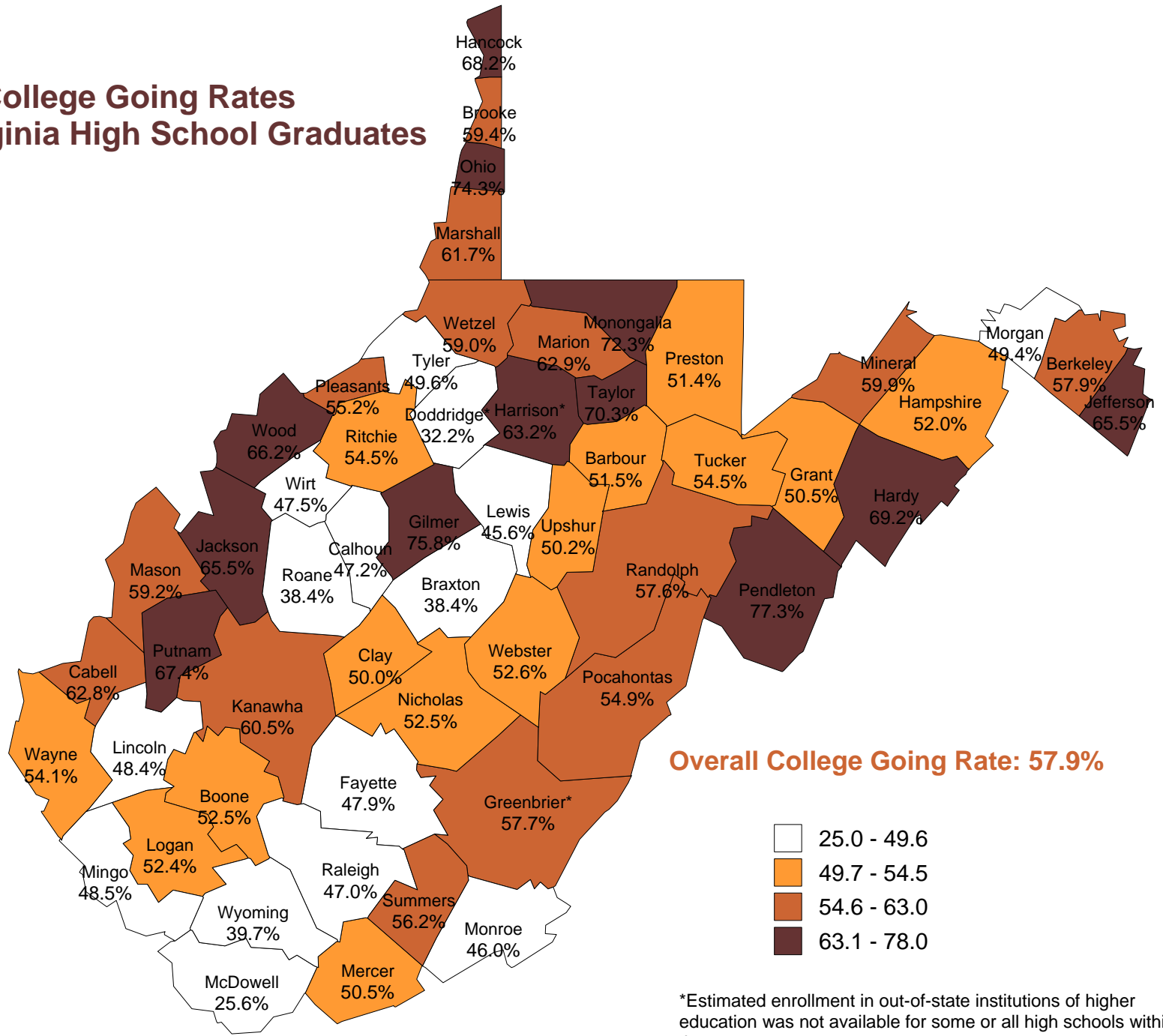

## West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2011

- Of the 18,001 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2010-11, an estimated 10,423 **(57.9%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the fall 2011 semester. This represents a **decrease of 0.9 of a percentage point in the overall rate** since last year. West Virginia public and degree-granting proprietary institutions experienced increases, while West Virginia independent and out-of-state institutions experienced decreases in their rates.
- 9,039 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (45.1%), independent (4.1%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.0%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 50.2%**, which represents a **decrease of 0.1 of a percentage point over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2011, it is estimated that another 1,384 **(7.7%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects a decrease of 0.8 of a percentage point over last year's figure.

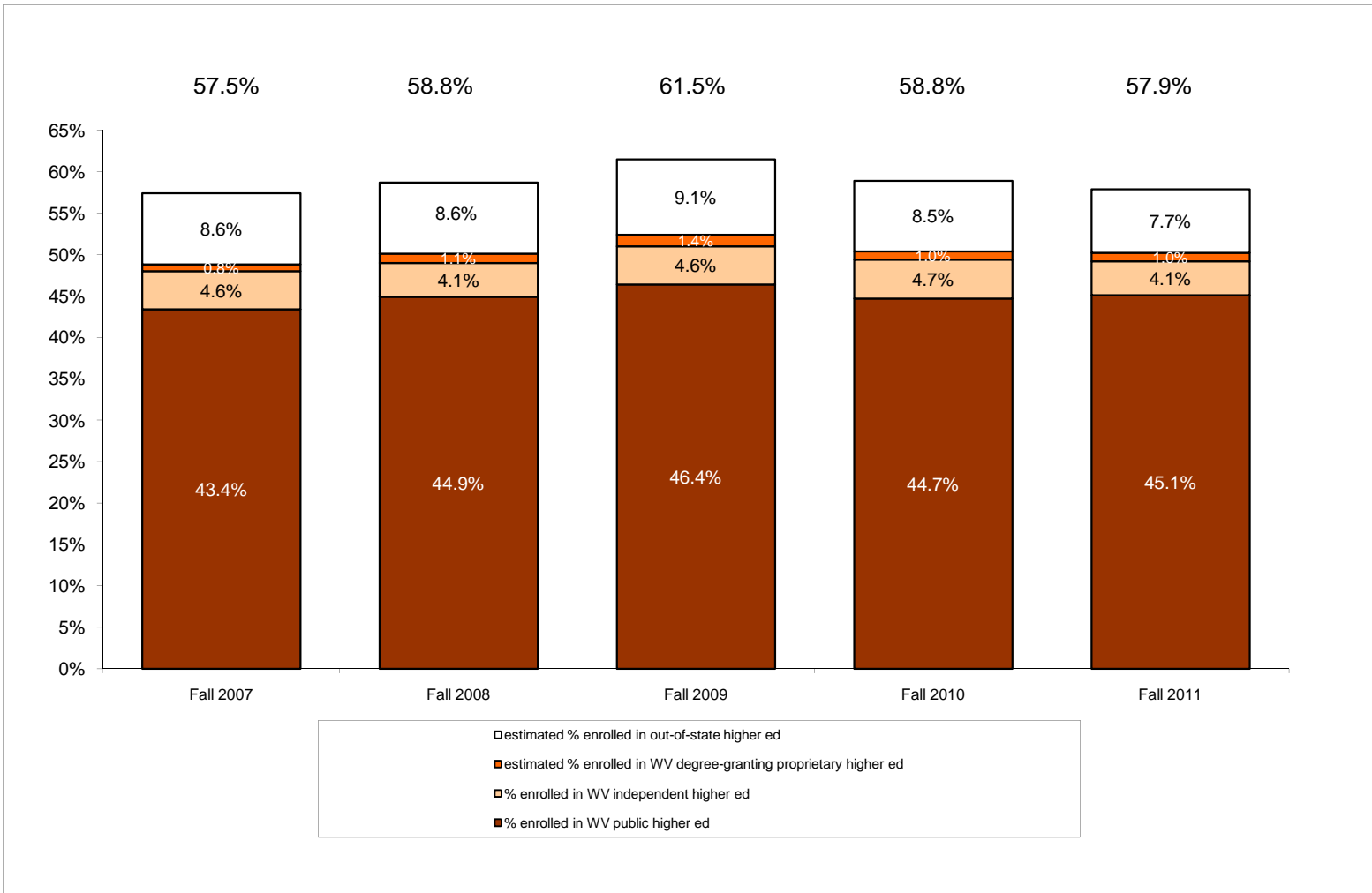

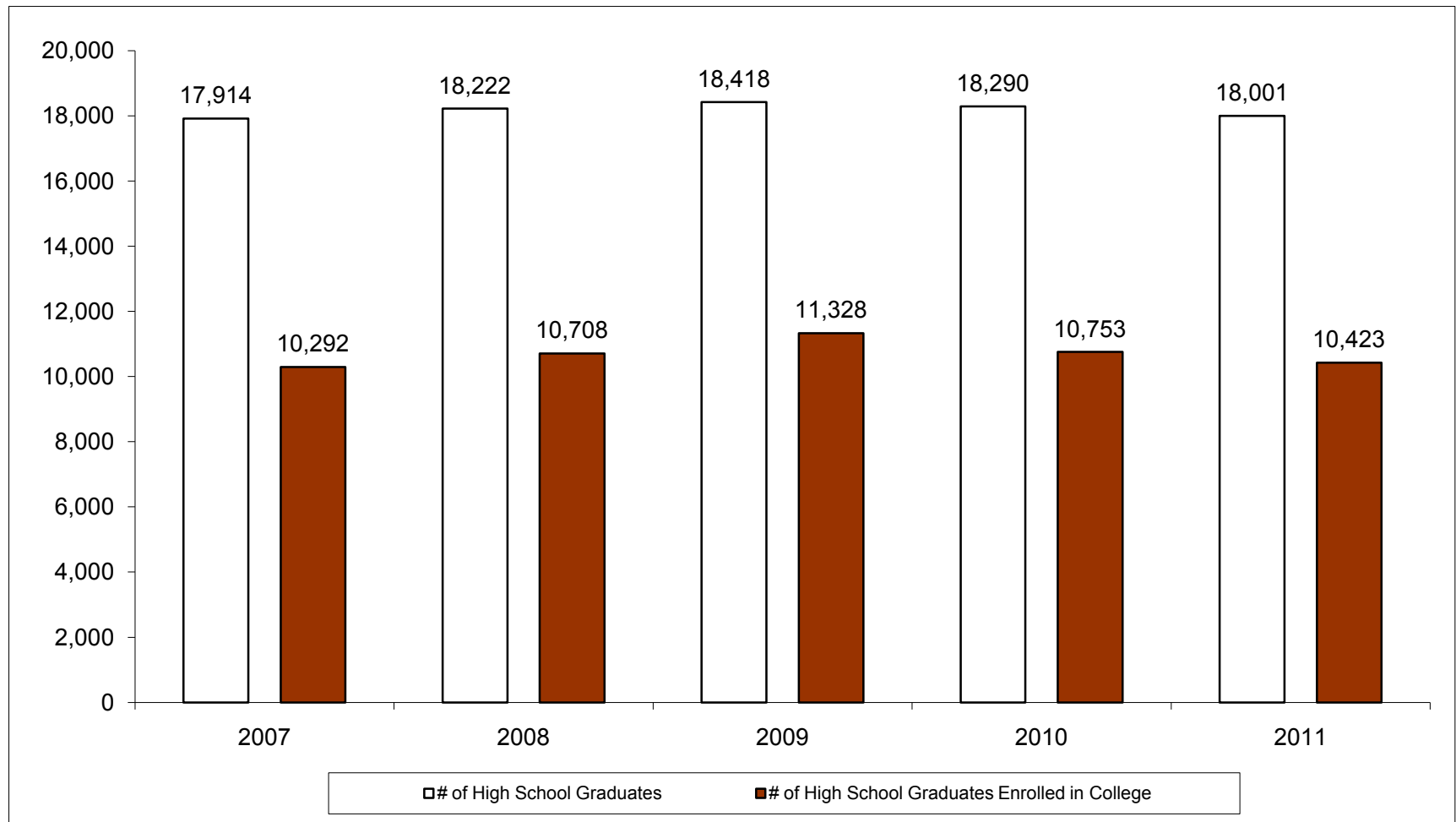

**Fall 2007 to Fall 2011**



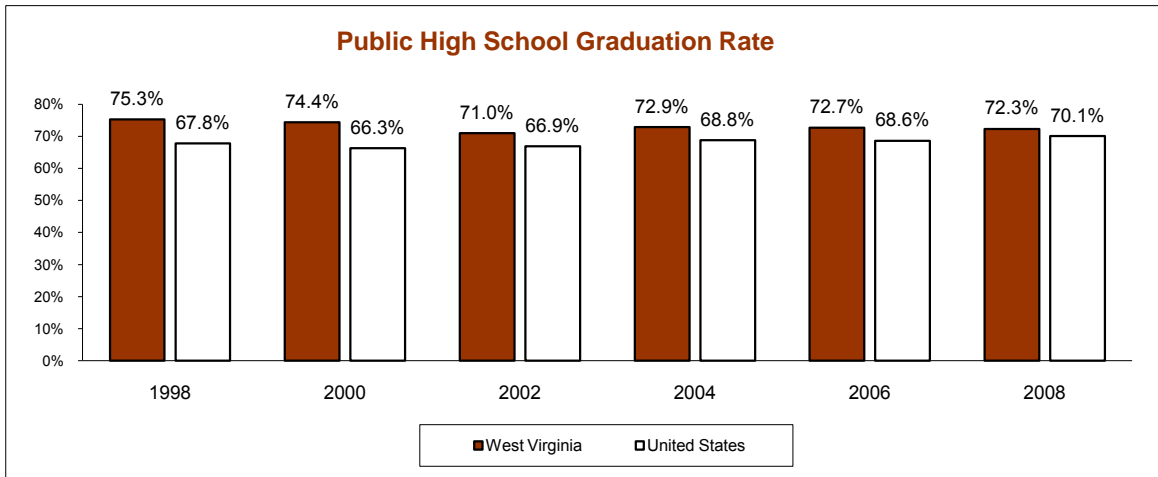

**2007-2011**

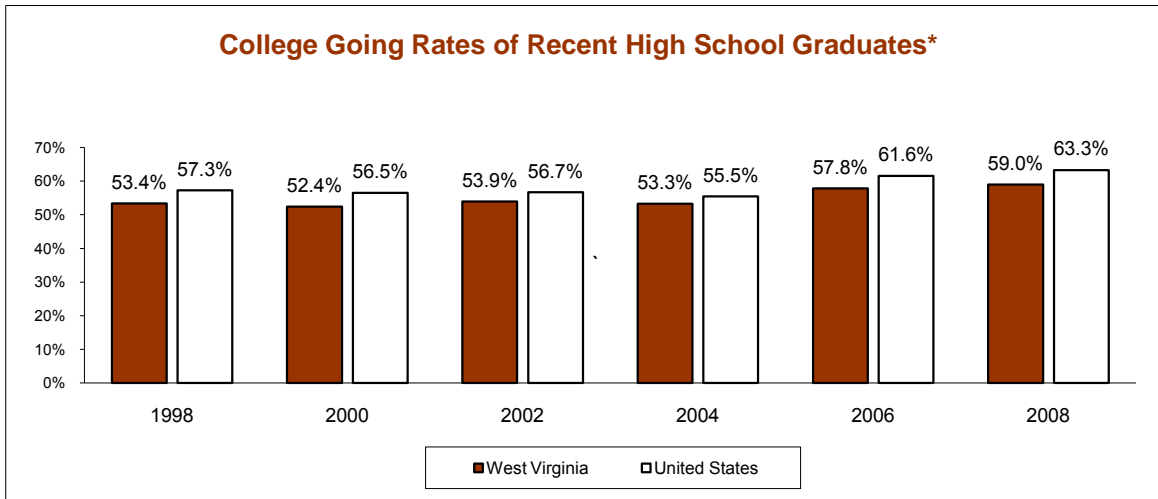

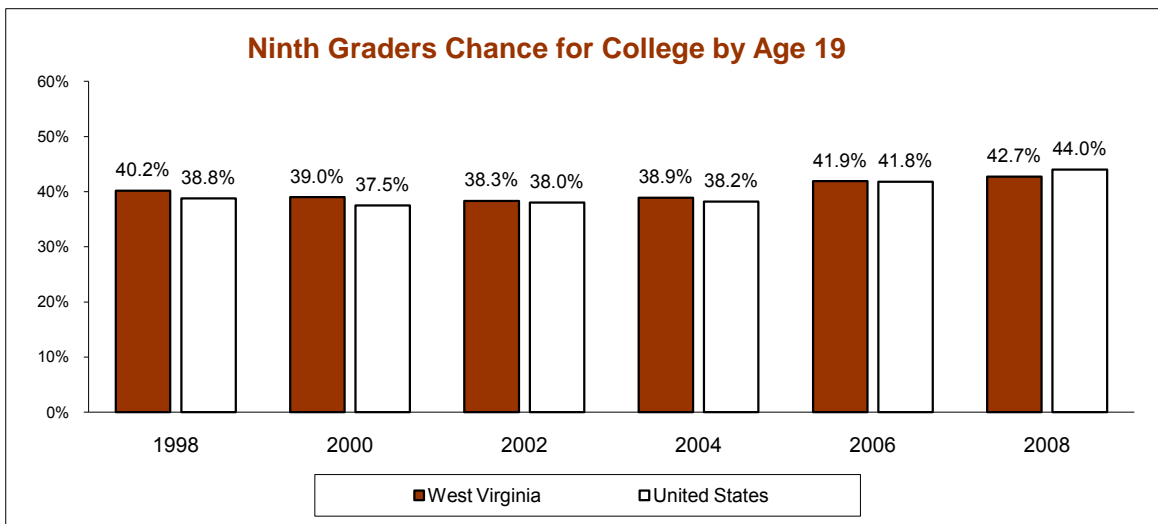
