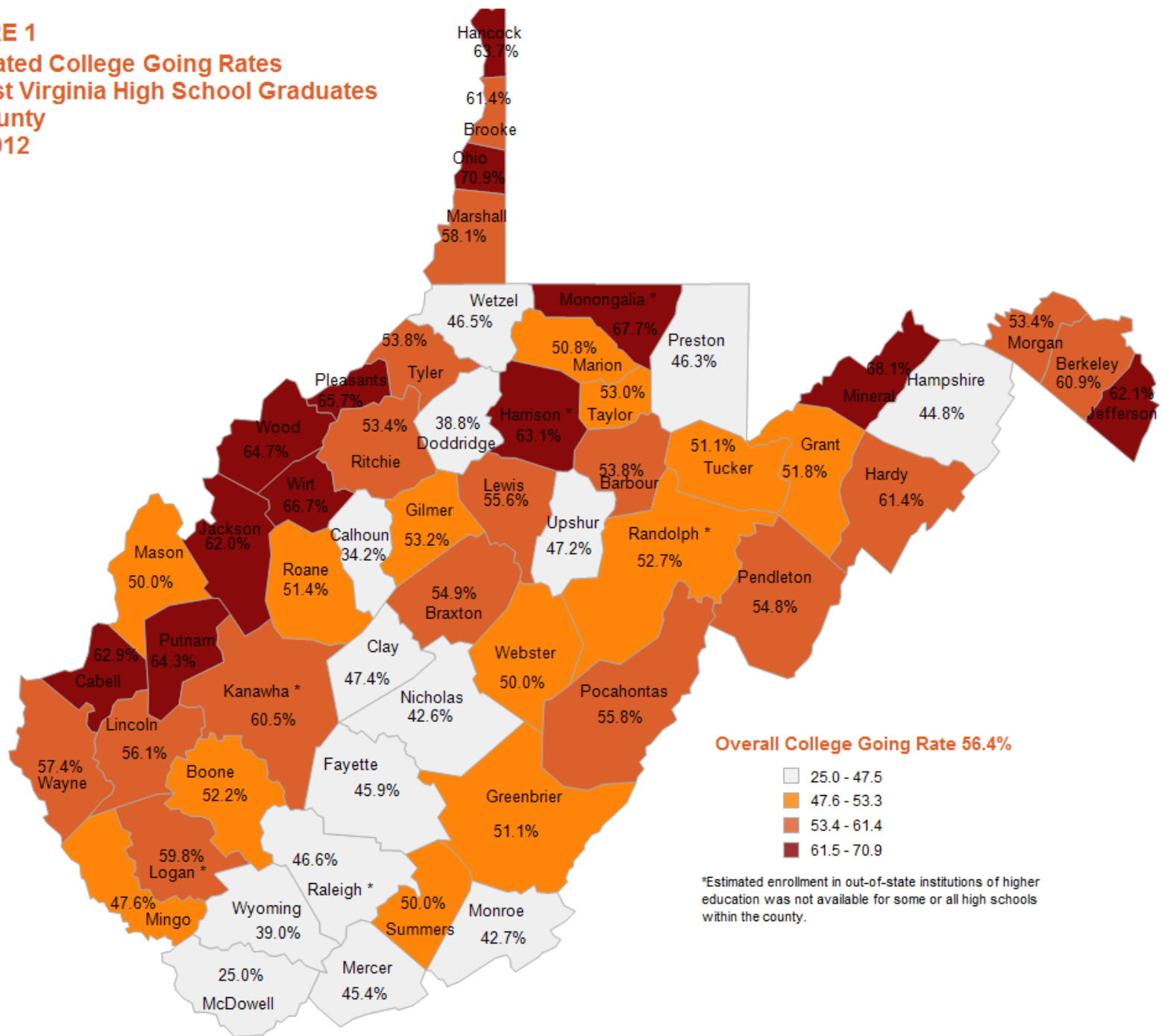

West Virginia College Going Rate Highlights Fall 2012

- Of the 18,335 students who graduated from public or private high schools in West Virginia during 2011-12, an estimated 10,342 **(56.4%) enrolled in higher education institutions** in the fall 2012 semester. This represents **a decrease of 1.5 percentage points in the overall rate** since last year and the lowest overall rate since 2002. West Virginia degree-granting proprietary institutions and out-of-state institutions experienced increases, while West Virginia public and independent institutions experienced decreases in their rates.
- 8,869 of these West Virginia high school graduates enrolled in one of the state's public (43.4%), independent (3.8%), or degree-granting proprietary (1.1%) colleges or universities. This generated an **in-state college going rate of 48.4%**, which represents **a decrease of 1.8 percentage points over last year's figure**.
- In addition to the high school graduates who enrolled in a West Virginia college or university in fall 2012, it is estimated that another 1,473 **(8.0%) were attending a college or university in another state**. This reflects an increase of 0.3 of a percentage point over last year's figure.

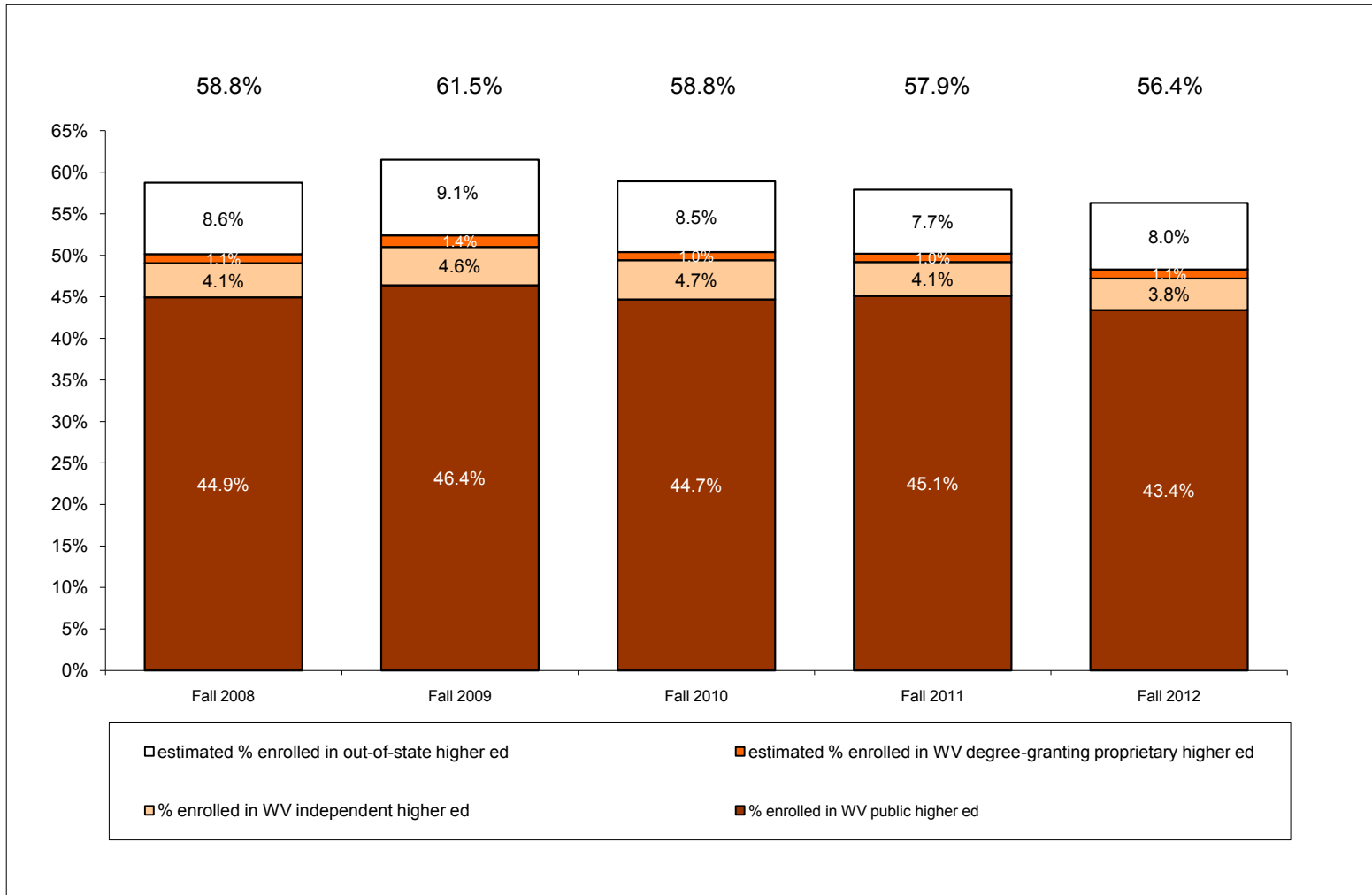

2008-2012

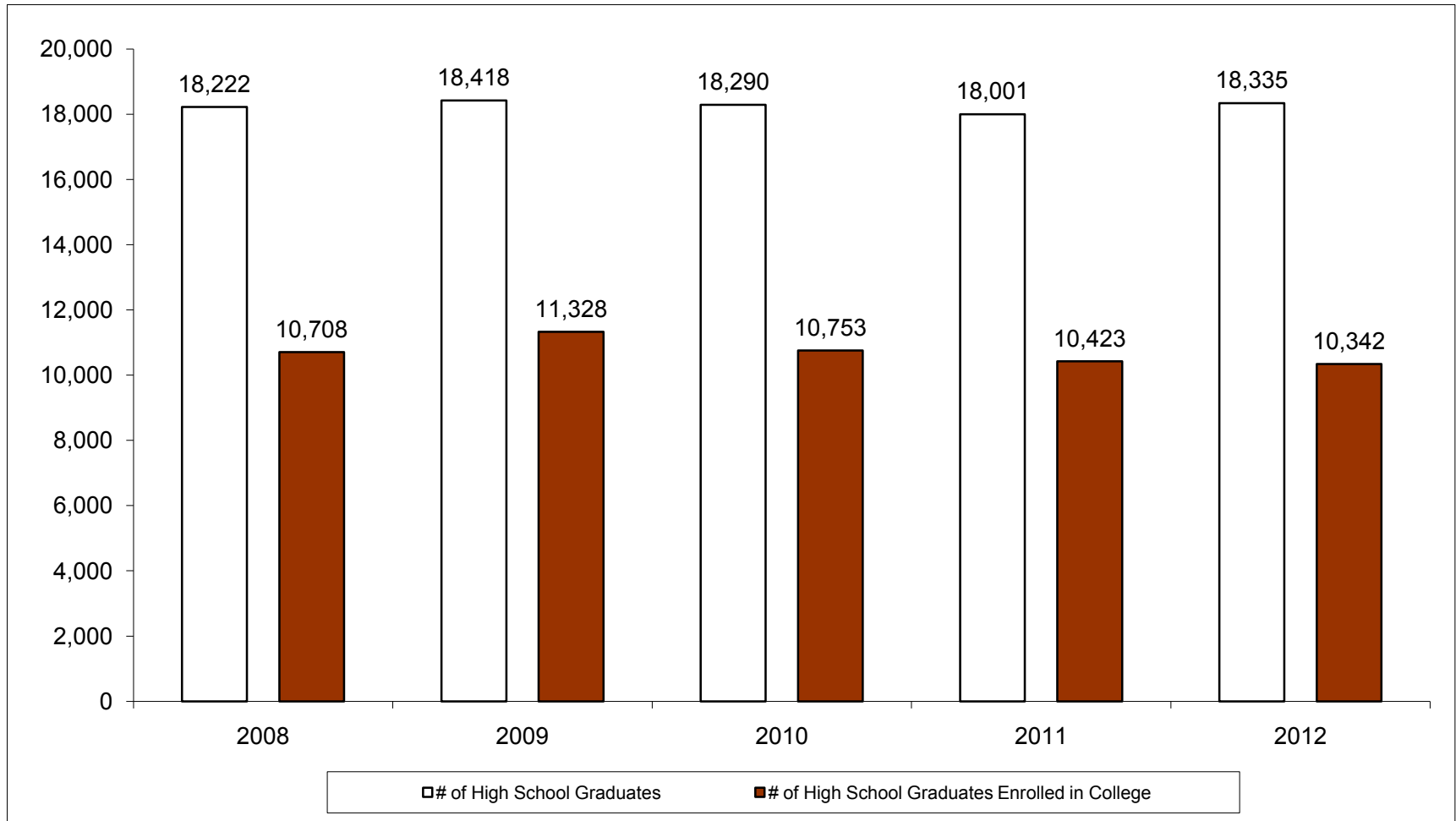
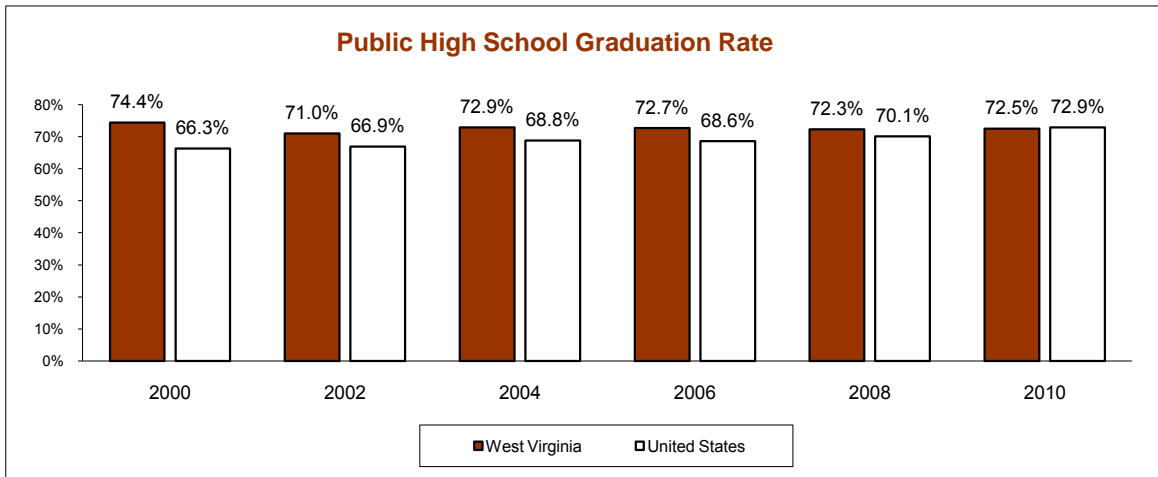
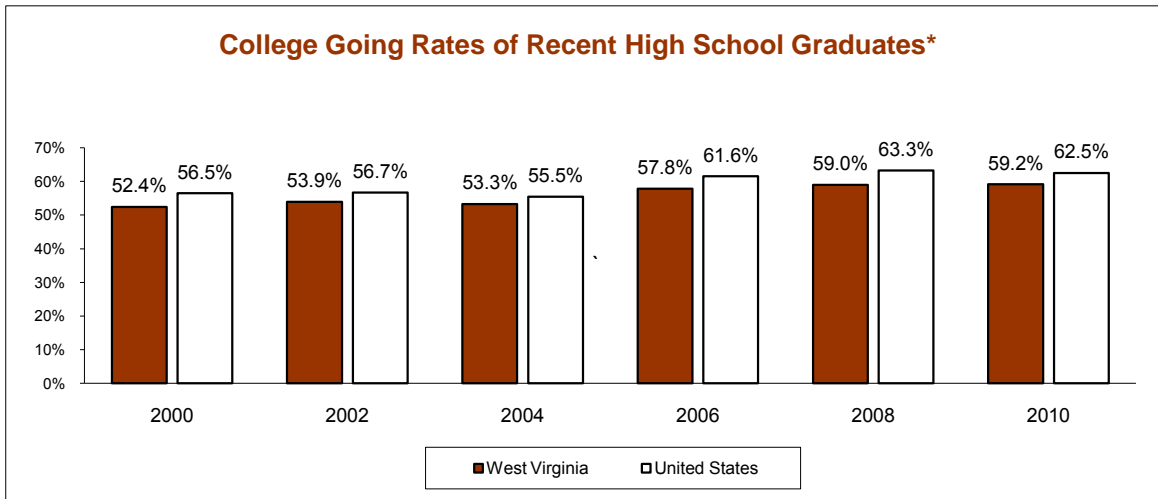

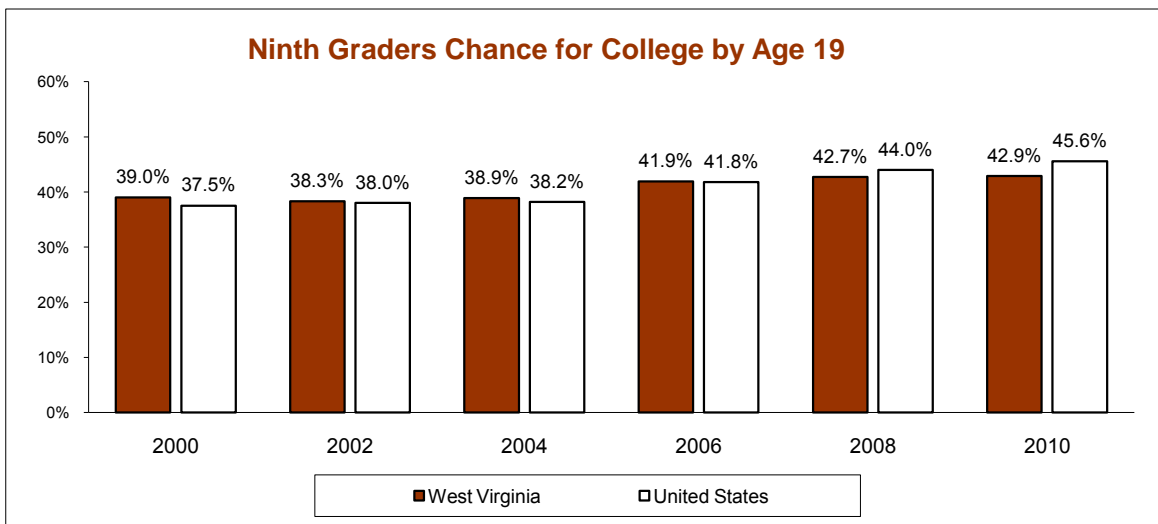
